



2. Engage citizens in policy design to truly understand the problem

3. Identify new sites of intervention to enable meaningful change


Fuel Poverty or Poverty?

Bristol





Conclusions

- Fuel Poverty is a distinct issue
- Existing policy fails to capture all the drivers
- Utilise a social practice perspective
- Fuel Poverty a complex issue
 - Householders trade-off between priorities
- More detail from householders = new sites of intervention → Chance to reduce Fuel Poverty
