

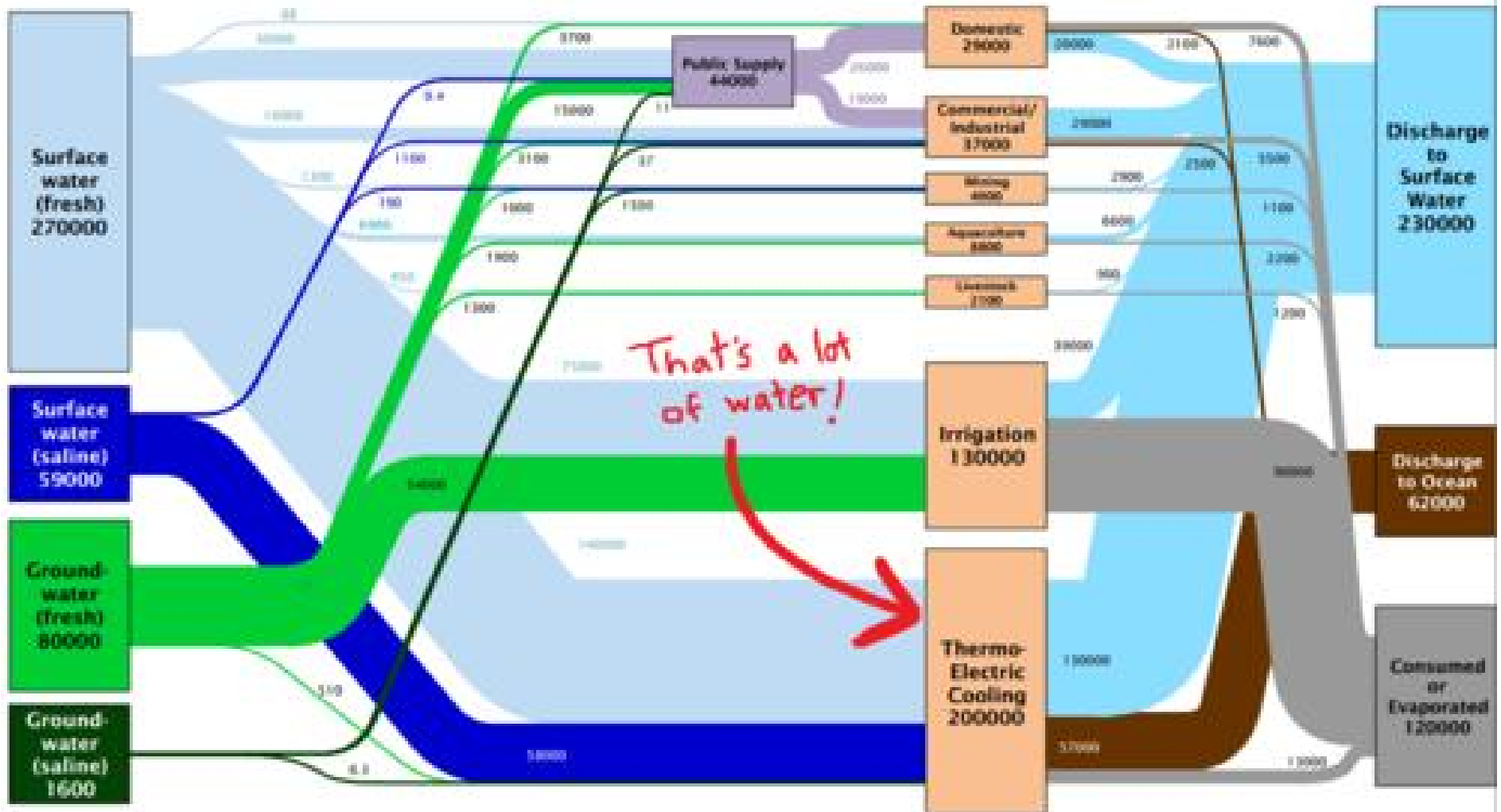

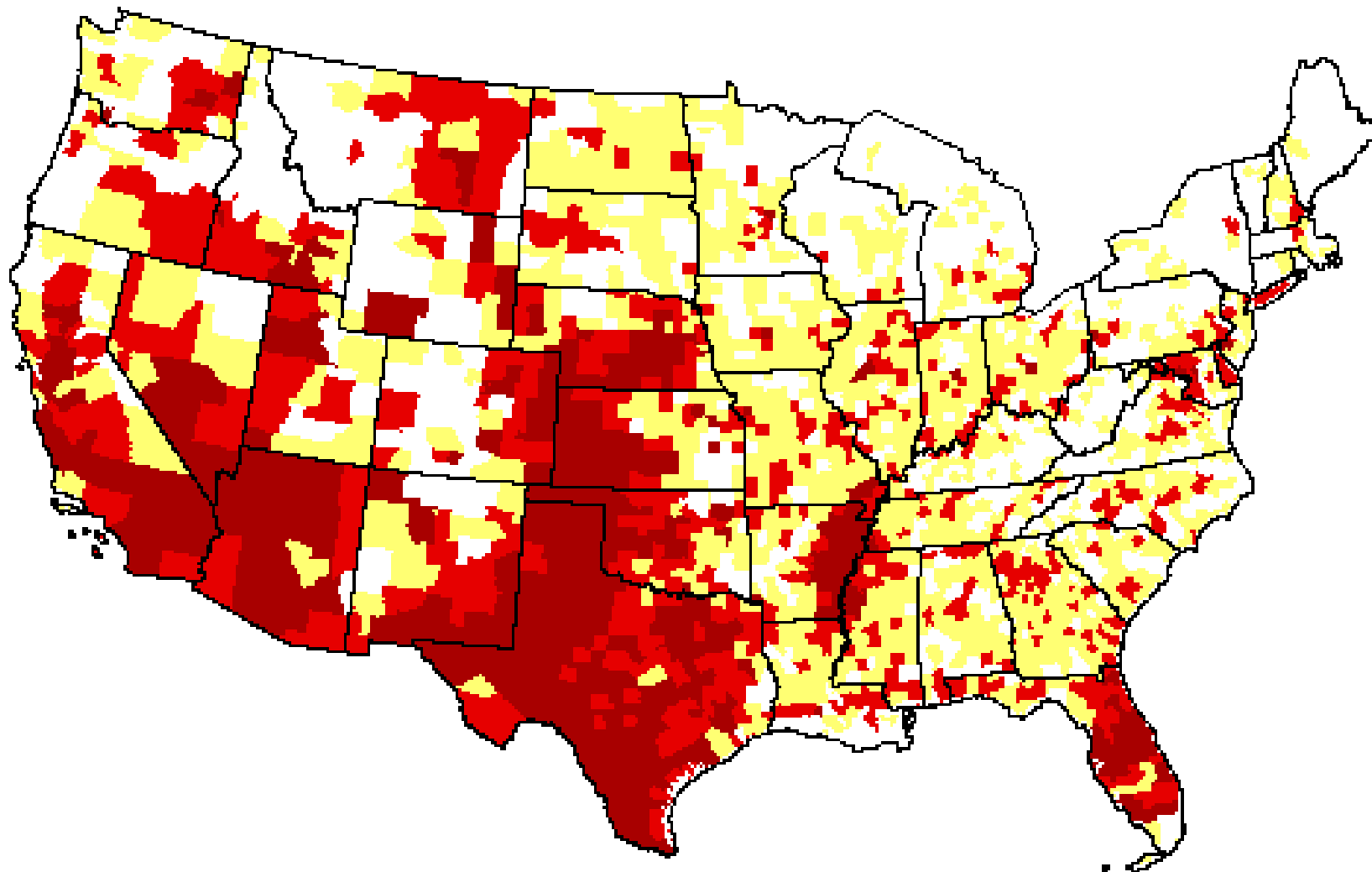


Estimated United State Water Flow in 2005: 410000 Million Gallons/Day

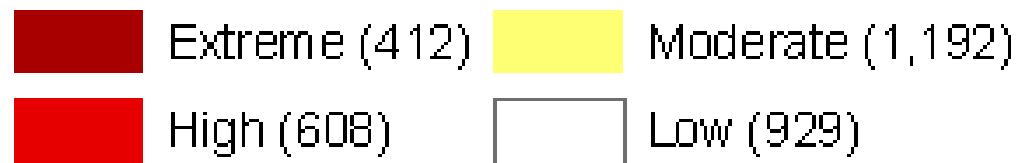
