It is the sole responsibility of the attendee to obtain the necessary paperwork for entry to the United States. This letter does not guarantee that you will be granted a visa, nor does it commit BECC to assist you in obtaining a visa. BECC will not pay any expenses incurred by you, to include travel and registration fees. We cannot send the letter to the embassy or consulate for you, nor can BECC contact the embassy or consulate on your behalf.
